



11 Things You Need to Know!!!

The Kalamazoo Promise is for ALL resident students of KPS. You cannot attend charter schools & earn credit toward The Kalamazoo Promise scholarship.

You must reside within the boundaries of KPS during all enrollment.

You must have at least all of the high school years (9-12) in KPS and graduate from KPS (Central, KILP, Loy Norrix, Phoenix).

The Kalamazoo Promise will never end. It is set up in perpetuity.

The Kalamazoo Promise is a scholarship for all post-secondary education: certificates, associates & bachelors are covered.

Up to 145 credit hours total eligibility. You have 10 years from graduation to use your Promise.

Trades are covered through certification or degree programs at state community colleges, the Michigan Career and Technical Institute (MCTI) and apprenticeships with Kalamazoo Electrical (KJATC) and Michigan Regional Council of Carpenters & Millwrights (MRCC).

Each high school has a Kalamazoo Promise Coach to help you personalize your Promise.

The Kalamazoo Promise covers tuition & mandatory fees.

Students sign up for The Kalamazoo Promise during senior year with their Promise Pathway Coach.

Meetings are held for all seniors each fall. There are two short forms to fill out to get The Promise.

There is an appeal process for students during their senior year, especially for hardship cases (e.g., homelessness, custody, death in the family, foster care placement).

Part-time status is acceptable for all students at KVCC, students enrolled during summer term, & on a case-by-case basis for all other students.
